





Their mission is to spy, steal and sabotage.






They target anyone who serves the nation. Soldiers, scientists and students all are prey to their unethical games.




APT36 uses a dirty malware arsenal known as RATs — like Crimson, Eliza and Capra.

One click can open window to our secrets. So.. Think before you tap.




And...APT36 deliberately targets scientists, government officers and diplomats trying to create chaos.







