1. Stay Informed from Trusted Sources
Follow verified government updates and reliable
news... Avoid unverified forwards.

- 2. Stay Alert to Security Warnings
 Pay attention to official alerts and follow
 safety instructions promptly.
- 3. Ensure Emergency Preparedness Keep basic supplies ready and know emergency contacts, routes, and shelters.
- 4. Limit Travel Near Border Areas
 Avoid border or conflict zones and follow all
 travel advisories.
- 5. Report Suspicious Activity
 Immediately inform authorities about anything
 unusual in your area.

1. Verify Before Sharing
Double-check sensational or emotional claims
with trusted sources.

- 2. Question Sensational Claims
 Treat fear-provoking headlines with caution and confirm their authenticity.
- 3. Avoid Unverified Content
 Never share news, images or videos that are
 not confirmed.
- 4. Educate Others
 Remind your friends and family to pause,
 check and share only what is true.


